#### **Course Name**

(1)Communication in Japanese (2) Discussion in Japanese

#### Introduction

"Communication in Japanese" and "Discussion in Japanese" are free and non-regular Japanese language courses offered by Mie University for students of our partner universities. Unfortunately, Mie University had decided to cancel acceptance of exchange students in Fall 2021 due to the spread of COVID-19, but we are going to conduct online Japanese courses so that you can experience learning at Mie University even a little.

We hope that you will be more interested in the Japanese language, Japanese culture, and Mie University through these courses.

#### **About the Courses:**

### (1)Communication in Japanese

- We have set three courses depends on the levels to give opportunities for all of the students of any Japanese level. Please check the attached files for the details of the lessons for each level.
- The duration is different for each level, but all the lessons are held every Tuesday of the Fall semester from 14:40 to 16:10 in Japan Standard Time.
- We use Zoom for the courses. The URL will be sent to the applicants directly about one week before start of each course.
- No textbooks are required for any courses, and the teacher will distribute them as needed.
- On the last day of each course, students can interact with Mie University students in Japanese.

## (2) Discussion in Japanese

- This course is for students of Japanese Language Proficiency Test N1 and N2 level. Please see the attached files for the details of the lessons for each level.
- This class has 13 lessons in total. All the lessons are held every Wednesday of the Fall semester from 16:20 to 17:50 in Japan Standard Time.
- We use Zoom for the courses. The URL will be sent to the applicants directly about one week before start of each course.
- Students can learn Japanese and Japanese culture through discussions with Mie University students in Japanese.

## **Applicants Capacity**;

- Up to 2 students from each university can apply.
- Only one course can be applied for by each person.
- The capacity is assumed to be 25 people for each course. Due to the operation of the course, if the number of applicants exceeds 25, we adjust the number of participants by lottery..

#### **Notes on the Course**;

- Since these courses are not a regular class at Mie University, we will not issue grades or certificates of completion.
- All courses will be held in Japan Standard Time, so please guide your students to apply for a course considering the time difference. Also, please guide them to apply for a course that suitable for their own Japanese level.

  The person in charge at the partner university should deal with the applicants within the university and create an Applicants List. Applications from the student himself / herself will not be accepted.
- Application Deadline: Tuesday, September 21, 2021
   The deadline is the same day for all courses.
