## Application Period

**Sept. 1 (WED) – Nov. 19 (FRI)**

## Eligibility

- Students currently enrolled in an accredited college/university
- Academically motivated high school students or high school graduates



## Application Materials

- 1 Copy of Academic Transcript
- 2 Copy of Passport
- 3 Proof of Health Insurance  
\*Only for students enrolled in an in-person course
- 4 Consent Letter signed by a legal guardian  
\*Only for pre-college students

\*Course selection to be completed through the online application form
- 2 Pay the application fee of KRW 100,000  
\*Non-refundable

- 4 Receive the 'Letter of Acceptance' via email
- 5 Pay the tuition and all remaining fees
