
Graduation Requirements


After PhD nursing students successfully complete the first year study with total 19 credits of coursework, they can take a comprehensive written PhD Qualifying exam. Students will be able to take the proposal defense and dissertation defense after they have passed their qualifying exam. Students will need to fulfill a Learning Achievement score by publishing their academic articles, presenting conference papers, or registering a (related product) patent. Each student also needs to have at least 14 days of international learning experience abroad at schools or organizations recognized internationally.

Admission Criteria

- 1. Do not have overseas Chinese status and do not hold a R.O.C. (Taiwan) passport at least for past eight years.
- 2. Have a master's degree in fields related to nursing or midwifery from universities and colleges approved by R.O.C. (Taiwan) Ministry of Education.
- *Applicants who have completed their master's degree at a non-English speaking academic institution, are required to have evidence of English proficiency equivalent to TOEFL iBT test score of 60 or IELTS 6.0 or higher.


