

学院概况

清华大学万科公共卫生与健康学院(卫健学院)成立于2020年4月2日,时值新冠肺炎疫情爆发并在全球大流行。学院的成立,是清华大学响应全球发展趋势和国家重大需求,积极承担使命的历史性举措,也是应对全球重大公共健康问题而及时做出的"学科响应"。

课程简介

清华大学于2014年设立此跨学科、跨文化的国际公共卫生硕士学位项目,齐聚基础医学、健康管理和社会医学等学科的知名专家、学者以及世界各地的合作伙伴于一堂,培养引领全球公共健康领域领导者。这些英语教学课程专门为发展中国家的卫生官员、疾病防治专业人员以及医疗服务机构的管理者量身定制。清华大学推出国际公共卫生硕士学位项目的目的是努力改善发展中国家的健康状况和健康公平性,旨在培养全球健康领域高层次知华友华爱华的领军人才。该项目将培训学生掌握公共卫生的基本理论和分析工具、了解中国卫生事业发展的成就、学习中国成功卫生事业管理和疾病控制经验,提高对重大健康问题的判断能力和解决实际问题的领导技能。

INTRODUCTION TO THE SCHOOL

The establishment of Tsinghua University Vanke School of Public Health is a timely demonstration of Tsinghua's capacity to shoulder its responsibilities as a globally-leading university. Tsinghua University Vanke School of Public Health aims to be a catalyst for high-level international cooperation and industry collaboration, delivering outstanding personnel training, academic faculty development and cutting-edge scientific research. With a strong foundation and mandate, the School will improve the national public health system and the overall national governance, as well as promote the development of global public health and human health undertakings.

PROGRAM DESCRIPTION

Tsinghua University offers a postgraduate degree focused on global public health. Known as "International Master of Public Health" (IMPH in abbreviation), this program is aimed at contributing to the cultivation of a new generation of leaders working in the public health sectors in the developing world. With the participation of faculty at Tsinghua University and scholars from other parts of the world, the program's courses are taught in English and specifically designed for health officials, personnel working on disease prevention and health program managers from developing countries. This orientation, however, does not exclude applicants from developed countries who are interested in issues of public health in less developed nations. Such issues include, among other things, health service delivery, product accessibility and global health governance.

SPECIFIC OBJECTIVES 1 We aim to develop the capability of students in applying theories and analytical tools of the public health discipline to their work. 2 We aim to enhance the understanding of students about public health issues in China and the developing world. 3 We aim to improve the ability of students to take on greater leadership roles in solving public health problems. 4 We aim to promote China's cooperation with other countries by building a network of cooperation between our faculty and our graduates to work on global public health issues.

Main Features of International Master of Public Health

PROGRAM STRUCTURE

The program's course work is consisted of four kinds of core courses to be completed in two semesters, and these include 8 courses on public health, a course made of field research and thesis preparation, a Chinese language course, and a course on Chinese society and culture taught explicitly from the perspectives of public health and medical care.

SCHOLARSHIPS

International students may apply for the Chinese Government Scholarship (CGS), the Beijing Government Scholarship (BGS), or the Tsinghua University Scholarship (TUS). We also administer a special Chinese Government Scholarship named Youth of Excellence Scheme of China (YES China) in collaboration with the Chinese Ministry of Education. YES China covers tuition fee, healthcare insurance accommodation and international travels. Applicants should first contact our school program office by email.

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

Applicants should be government health officials, professionals in the field of disease control and prevention, and managers of medical service organizations from developing countries. Applicants should be healthy, well-behaved and with the appropriate qualifications.

- Three years working experience in public health or relevant areas
- Excellent command of English
- Less than 45 years old
