**Program Purpose**

KMOU was selected as the host university to carry out a governmental-funded project, "Global Maritime and Ocean Science Invitation Program". This program is designed to provide international students with opportunities to study in the field of maritime and ocean at KMOU at the level of undergraduate. The program consists of ① **Educational courses** ② **Field trips** ③ **Mentoring with KMOU graduate students** ④ **Research and Presentation** etc.

**Eligibility**

1. Applicants must be enrolled in full-time undergraduate program at their home universities that have made an academic exchange agreement (MoU etc.) with KMOU especially AMFUF members.
2. Applicants must be enrolled and pay tuition fee at their home university as full-time students during the study period in Korea.
3. Applicants must have a high academic record their home university
4. Applicants are proficient in English.
  - Non-native English speakers must have a score of at least TOEFL iBT 79, IELTS 6.0, TOEIC 780, CEFR B2 or CET-6 485.
  - If applicants don't have their own English score, the official letter written by their advising professor would be available to verify their English ability equivalent to the above scores.
5. Applicants must have sound mind and good health during their study period in Korea.
6. Applicants must complete their vaccinations on COVID-19.
7. Applicants' major could be similar to maritime and ocean science.

**Application Procedure**

1. Home university's international coordinator will provide students with application forms.
2. Students will complete and prepare all documents.
3. Home university's international coordinator send all together with required documents.
4. KMOU will review applications.
5. KMOU will notify successful candidates and issues further instructions.

9. Passport Copy-Personal Information page (Be valid during the prospective stay in Korea)

### Scholarship

1. According to an agreement, KMOU tuition fee for Fall 2022 will be waived.
2. Supported by KMOU: Round-trip airfares, Dormitory fees (with meals), Field Trip fees, Part of Quarantine fees (if necessary) and other official program fees

*Note: Participants must bear their own living expenses, National Health Insurance (about KRW 50,000/month), Foreign Registration fee (about KRW 30,000) etc.*

**COVID-19 Information updated on April 1, 2022**

1. Quarantine Policy

From April 1, 2022, those who have completed overseas vaccinations will be exempted from quarantine if they use the Q-code to enter quarantine information in advance.

B) Accepted WHO COVID-19 vaccines: Pfizer, Janssen, Moderna, AZ, Covishield (AZ-Serum Institute of India), Sinopharm (Beijing), Sinovect, Covaxin, Novavax, Covishield

C) Who is considered vaccinated?

- Those who received the second (1st for Janssen) shot of WHO COVID-19 vaccine within 14 to 180 days OR the 3rd (Booster shot) abroad

2. PCR test before taking a flight to Korea

All travelers entering the Republic of Korea are required to submit pre-departure negative COVID-19 PCR test results upon arrival. Travelers without a valid test result will be prohibited from boarding the flight.

A) Time of testing and issuance of PCR negative certification

From January 20, 2022, the testing must have been performed and the PCR negative certificate must have been issued within 48 hours before the departure date.

B) Required items: Name, Date of Birth, Test Method, Test Date, Test Result, Date of Issuance and Name of testing center

C) The test result must be NEGATIVE. If the test result is "Indeterminate", "Unclear", "Positive", the relevant result is invalid.

D) Language: Must be written in Korean OR English
